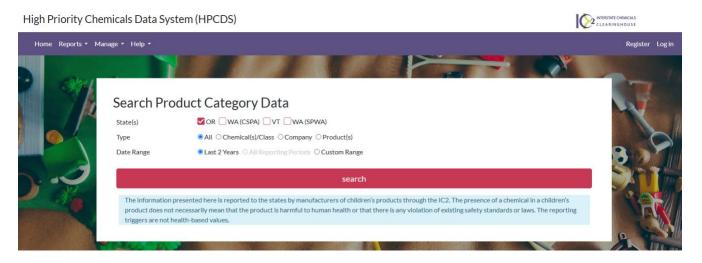
# High Priority Chemicals Data System (HPCDS) User Guide to Searching HPCDS Data May 27, 2025

- Who is this User Guide intended for?
  - O This User Guide is intended for consumers of data to search data reported by manufacturers of children's products under <a href="Washington State's Children's Safe Products Act">Washington State's Children's Safe Products Act</a>, <a href="Oregon's Toxic Free Kids Act">Oregon's Toxic Free Kids Act</a>, and Vermont's 2014 Act 188 (Vermont Statute Title 18 38A Vermont Chemicals of High Concern to Children), and priority chemicals in general consumer products required by Safer Products for Washington (SPWA). Consumers of data include: potential purchasers or owners of children's and other consumer products; researchers; non-governmental organizations (NGOs); and government agencies.
- Do I need to register for an HPCDS account to search the data?
  - O No, you only need to register with HPCDS if you are a reporting manufacturer.

- The HPCDS is optimized for Chrome and may not work with other browsers.
- Your use of the HPCDS constitutes acceptance of the <u>Terms of Service</u>.

## Search Product Category Data

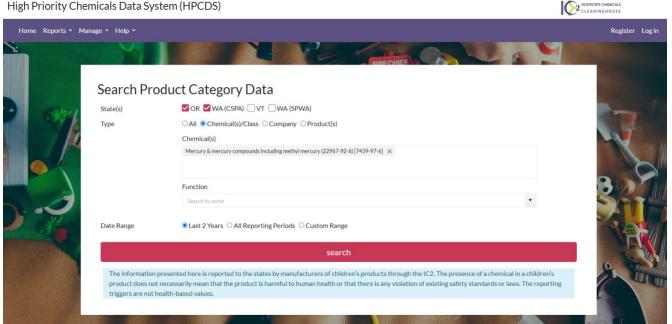
1. Click Reports from the top navigation and then Search Product Category Data from the menu oruse this direct link: <a href="https://hpcds.theic2.org/Search">https://hpcds.theic2.org/Search</a>. Here you can view all published reports on the presence of chemicals of concern in children's products required by the Oregon Toxic Free Kids Act (TFKA), the Washington Children's Safe Products Act (CSPA), Vermont Statute Title 18 38A Vermont Chemicals of High Concern to Children, and priority chemicals in consumer products required by Safer Products for Washington (SPWA).  Select one or more states using the checkboxes. Next, choose the type of data to narrow the search. Select All to search by all data, Chemical(s)/Class, Company, or Product(s) using the radio buttons.



3. Search by chemical name or CASRN (Chemical Abstracts Service Registry Number) for OR, WA (CSPA) or VT by typing in the text box and/or using the drop-down list. You can also search by chemical function using the drop-down list. You may search for more than one chemical at a time. For WA (SPWA), search by chemical class. To view all available SPWA reporting classes, type "class" into the Chemical(s) box before selecting. You may search for more than one chemical class at a time.

### High Priority Chemicals Data System (HPCDS)

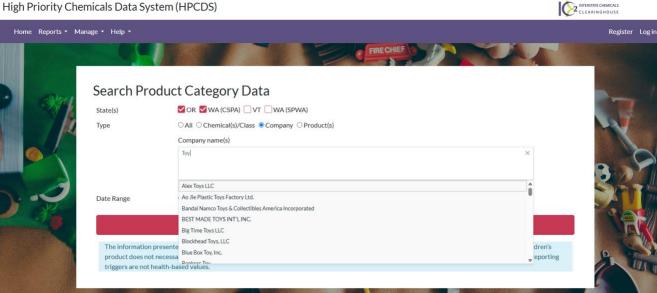


IMPORTANT: No results will appear for WA (SPWA) if a specific chemical or CASRN are searched. The chemical name and CASRN will appear with the chemical class search results.

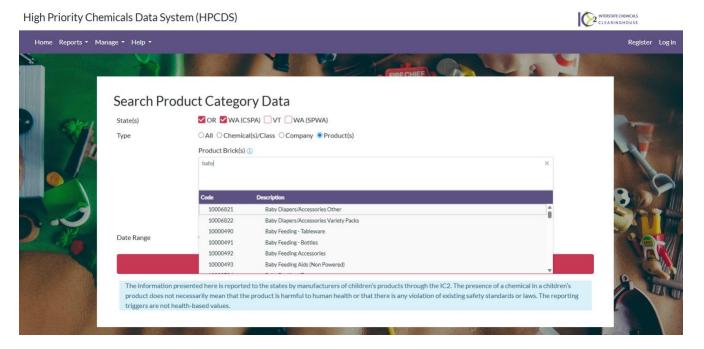
Recommendation: Search WA (SPWA) reports separately when selecting Chemical/Class. WA (SPWA) data originates at the class level.

4. Search by company name by typing in the text box. As you type, companies in the system that match your search will appear in a drop-down list. Select the company or companies from that list. You may search for more than one company at a time.

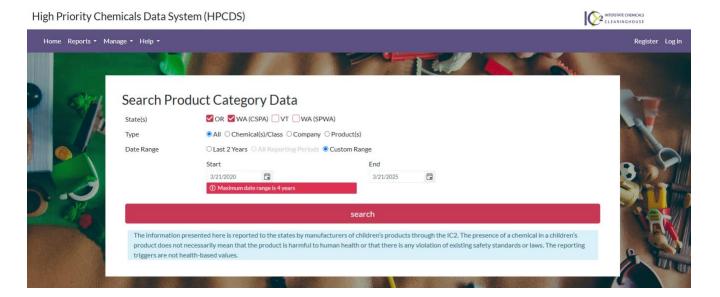




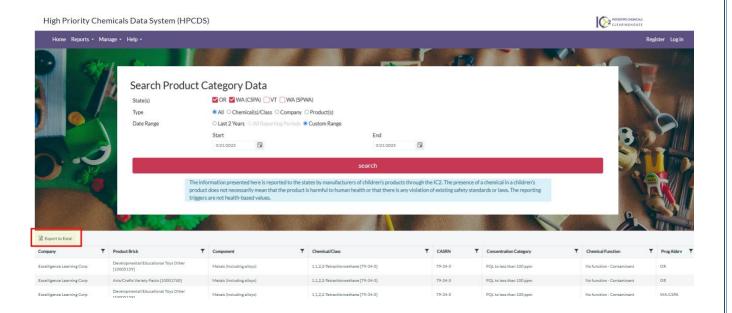
5. For products, search by brick name or brick code by typing in the text box and/or by using thedrop-down list. "Brick" refers to a product category and means the "brick" level of the GS1 Global Product Classification (GPC) standard, which identifies products that serve a common purpose, are of a similar form and material, and share the same set of attributes. You may search for more than one product at a time. 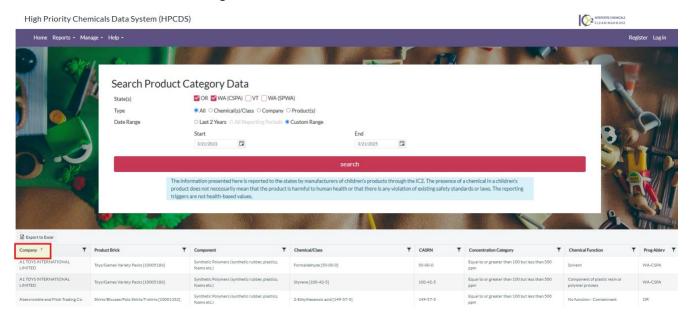
**6.** To search by date, select from Last 2 Years, All Reporting Periods, or Custom Date Range using the radio buttons. You can only search for All Reporting Periods if you have selected a search type other than All due to the volume of data. For the custom date range, you cannot exceed a range of greater than 4 years.



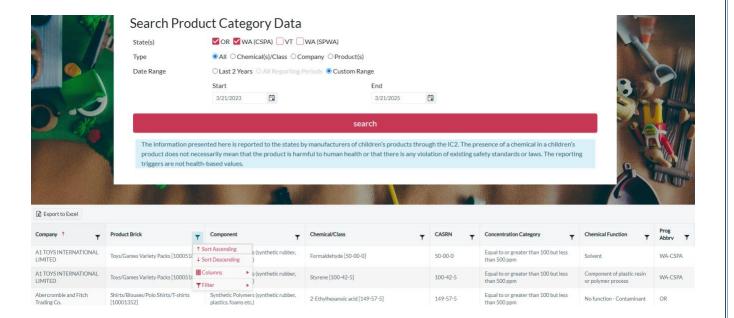
7. Once you have finished selecting your search criteria, click the Search button. Your search results will appear below the criteria. Export your search results to an Excel file by clicking the Export to Excel button located above the search results table.



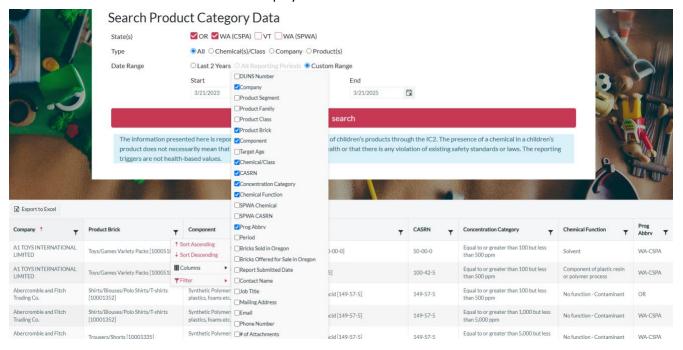
**8.** Each column in the search results table is sortable. To sort the results table by column, click on the column name. Click again to reverse the sort order.



9. Each column in the search results table is filterable. To filter a column, click on the filter funnel icon ( <sup>▼</sup> ) next to the column name. In the pop-up, select filter and then use the drop-down lists and text fields to enter your filtering criteria.



10. Additional columns of data are available to view in the results table. Click the filter funnel icon on any column heading. In the pop-up, select columns, and then use the check boxes to add or remove columns from the table display.



IMPORTANT: To view chemicals reported to SPWA, check boxes SPWA Chemical and SPWA CASRN

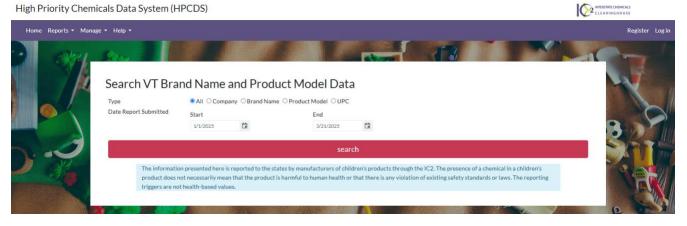

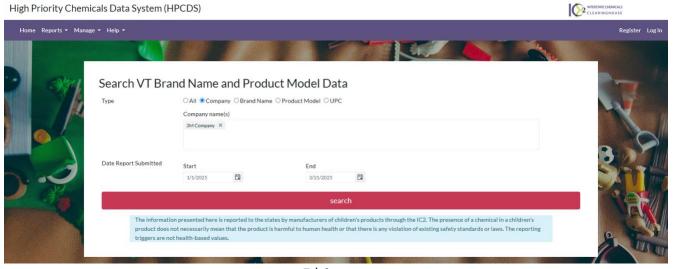

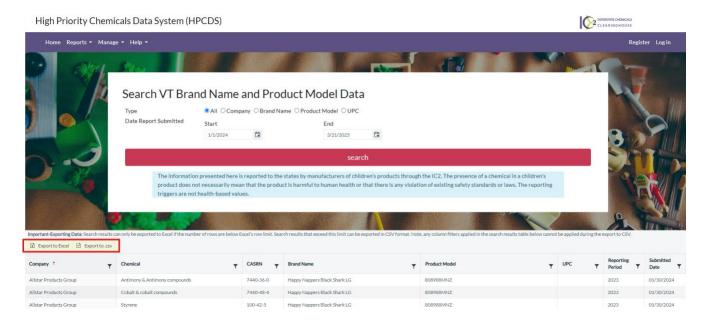

The presence of a chemical in a children's product does not necessarily mean that the product is harmful to human health or that there is any violation of existing safety standards or laws. The reporting triggers are not health-based values.

2. Select the search type: All, Company, Brand Name, Product Model, or UPC (abbreviation for "Universal Product Code", which refers to a 12-digit barcode number). For "All", you may enter the "Start" and "End" date to search the date range that the report was submitted. For all the other search types, after choosing the search type (for example, "Company"), enter a value in the search box and "Start" and "End" dates.

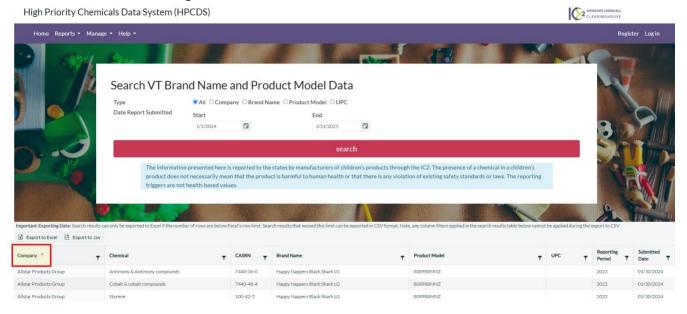




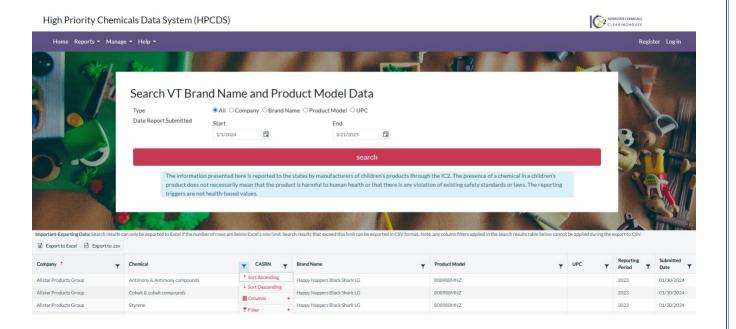
3. Once you have finished selecting your search criteria, click the Search button. Your search results will appear below the criteria. Export your search results to an Excel or .csv file by clicking the Export to Excel or Export to CSV button located above the search results table. Note, search results can only be exported to Excel if the number of rows are below Excel's row limit. Search results that exceed this limit can be exported in CSV format. Note, any column filters applied in the search results table below cannot be applied during the export to CSV.



**4.** Each column in the search results table is sortable. To sort the results table by column, click onthe column name. Click again to reverse the sort order.

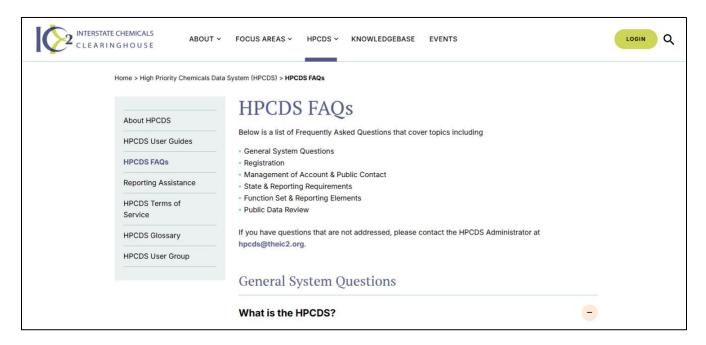


5. Each column in the search results table is filterable. To filter a column, click on the filter funnel icon ( ) next to the column name. In the pop-up, select filter and then use the drop-down lists and text fields to enter your filtering criteria.
